

FAFSA Checklist

Here is a list of items necessary to complete a FAFSA form (Pell Grant). You need to obtain a PIN (personal identification number) for the parent and the student, so the application can be signed online. This is also necessary in order to access your FAFSA form in case you need to make changes on it later. The pin number can be obtained at www.pin.edu.gov or go to www.fafsa.ed.gov and locate the link. After you register for a pin, you will receive your pin and further instructions via e-mail in 2-3 days.
